JQL AI - User Guide

Introduction

JQL AI is a Jira app designed to simplify complex JQL searches by converting natural language queries into accurate JQL statements. Whether you're a beginner or an experienced Jira user, JQL AI helps you find issues faster without needing to memorize complex syntax.

Features

- AI-powered JQL conversion from natural language queries
- Supports both Global Search and Project-Specific Search
- Quick actions for frequently used JQL queries
- Admin settings for enabling/disabling the app per project
- Copy and search JQL results directly in Jira

Installation

- 1. Go to the Atlassian Marketplace and search for JQL AI.
- 2. Click **Get it now** and install the app in your Jira instance.
- 3. Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the installation.
- 4. Navigate to a Jira project or the global search page to start using JQL AI.

Getting Started

Once installed, JQL AI is accessible via:

- Global Search: Available in the Jira navigation menu for system-wide searches.
- **Project Page**: Available inside Jira projects for project-specific searches.
- Admin Page: Manage settings and permissions from the Jira Admin panel.

How to Use JQL AI

1. Enter a Query

• Type a natural language query like:

- "Find all open issues"
- "Show all closed tasks from last week"
- "Find issues assigned to John Doe in Project X"
- Press Enter or click Convert to generate the JQL query.

2. Review and Use the JQL Query

- The app displays the converted JQL query.
- Options:
 - **Copy**: Click the copy button to use the query elsewhere.
 - **Search in Jira**: Open the Jira issue search page with the query pre-applied.

3. Quick Actions

- Use pre-configured quick actions such as:
 - Open Issues
 - Closed Issues
 - In-Progress Issues
- Click a quick action to generate the respective JQL query instantly.

Admin Settings

Admins can enable or disable JQL AI at different levels:

- Global Level: Apply JQL AI across all projects.
- **Project Level**: Enable or disable JQL AI per project.
- Security Filters: The app automatically filters inappropriate content in queries.

Troubleshooting

Issue: The app is disabled

• Contact your Jira admin to check if JQL AI is enabled for your project or globally.

Issue: "Something went wrong" error

- Ensure you have a valid OpenAI API key configured.
- Verify your internet connection and try again.

Issue: "Project-specific queries only" error

- If using JQL AI inside a project, ensure your query does not reference multiple projects.
- Use **Global Search** for multi-project queries.
